administrative matters cont'd:

Code of AR Rule (CAR) – The BLR draft Rules of the Board (reformatted into Code of Arkansas Rules (17 CAR §285) was reviewed and Agency Feedback provided. Revisions have been completed and the final version will be presented during the Board's May meeting.

Department of Labor and Licensing (ADLL) Report;

- Board Appointments/Reappointments – Members with term end date of June 30, 2023 (Tudor PE Member, Moore PE Member, & Scott Consumer Member) – the Director has informed ADLL and the Governor's Office of the Board's support for their reappointment.
- The FY25 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between ADLL and PEPS includes Administrative Costs for ADLL Executive Salaries of \$31,953.02/\$2,662.75 a month. Motion was made (Moore moved, Perry seconded) and carried to execute the MOU.
- The 2024 Fiscal Session for FY25 will begin April 10, 2024.
- AR Legislative Council–PEER, the request for additional FY24 appropriation of \$6,000 for salaries and matching is scheduled for review today, March 12, 2024.
- Legislative Audit's FY2023 Internal Compliance Assessment of ADLL began on January 2, 2024.
- The PELS Website will move to ADLL format in April 2024.

Justin Hall v Board appeal 60CV-23-8986 – On November 27, 2023, Justin W. Hall and Hall Engineering, LTD filed a Petition for Review and Stay of an Order of Board 60CV-23-8986. The Board was served on January 8, 2024 and on February 5, 2024, the Board filed a response. Agency Counsel is working with Respondents Counsel on a briefing schedule.




The Hearing ended and business being thus concluded the meeting adjourned at 3:00 pm.
