Completion of Building Renovations 2016-2017

Board Elects New Officers for 2017-2018

At its May 2017 meeting, the Board elected Scott Bennett, P.E., and Brian Moore, P.E. as President and Vice-President, respectively.



PRESIDENT Scott Bennett, P.E., Little Rock, Arkansas

Scott graduated from the University of Arkansas - Fayetteville with B.S. and M.S. Civil Engineering degrees in 1989 and 1994 respectively. He has been a Professional Engineer since 1994.

Scott began his career with the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) as a summer employee from 1985 to 1988. Upon graduation, he was hired as a Civil Engineer I – Planning Division. He's held the positions of Planning Engineer, Transportation Engineer, Section Head of Technical Services, Assistant Division Head of Planning and Research, Assistant Division Head of Programs and Contracts, Division Head of Planning and Research, and Assistant Chief Engineer – Planning. In 2011 he became the current Director of the Department.

Scott has also been appointed by Governor Hutchinson to serve on the Governor's Working Group on Highway Funding.

Scott is an Engineer member of the Board, appointed in 2015, and his term will expire in 2019.



BOARD VICE-PRESIDENT Brian Moore, P.E., Springdale, Arkansas

Brian graduated from the University of Arkansas - Fayetteville with a B.S. in Civil Engineering in 1994. He has been a Professional Engineer in Arkansas since 2000. He also maintains P.E. licenses in Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma, Tennessee and Texas.

Brian began his engineering career at Engineering Services, Inc. (ESI) in 1992 while working on his B.S.C.E degree. Upon graduation he became full-time and he is currently Vice President and part owner of ESI.

Brian was one of *Northwest Arkansas Business Journal's* "Forty Under Forty" in 2003, and was named the 2005 Young Engineer of the Year by the Northwest Chapter of the Arkansas Society of Professional Engineers (ASPE). REPORT ON DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS
Taken by the Board since October 2016

CASE NUMBER #2013-13, In the matter of Robert Allan Callicot, P.S.

COMPLAINT: Robert Callicot was paid \$1000 by his client Charles McGowan and never provided Mr. McGowan with a survey.

RESOLUTION: On March 14, 2017 Robert Callicot entered into a Consent Agreement and Order with the Board and was assessed a civil penalty of \$1000 for violations of Arkansas Code §17-42-205(a)(1)(K) & §17-42-205(a)(1)(E).

CASE NUMBER #2017-03, in the matter of John Millett, Non Renewed P.E.

COMPLAINT: John Millett conducted engineering services without an active license. Mr. Millett failed to renew his license and provided engineering services on three separate occasions while his license was non-renewed.

RESOLUTION: On August 11, 2017 John Millett entered into a Consent Agreement and Order with the Board and was assessed a civil penalty of \$250 for each violation of Article 1.A of the Rules of the Board and for a total Civil penalty of \$750

CASE NUMBER #2017-05, in the matter of Jason Needham, P.E.

COMPLAINT: Alleged misconduct in practicing engineering. Mr. Needham was convicted of a felony in Federal court in the Western District of Tennessee

RESOLUTION: On August 6, 2017, Needham entered into a Consent Agreement and Order with the Board and surrendered his professional engineer license. Needham was found in violation of Article 14(A)(3) of the Rules of the Board as well as a violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-305(a)(2)(A).

Rule and Exam Changes.....

- **Surveyor Rules:**

The sunset period outlined in a 2009 Rule change (surveyors could qualify for licensure by experience only) ended January 1, 2017.

In 2009, the Arkansas Legislature passed Act 392, changing the licensure qualifications for Surveyor Intern (SI) and Professional Surveyor (PS) applicants effective January 1, 2017. This was soon followed by the Board adopting Rules which incorporated the Act 392 licensure changes.

The most significant change to the Rule, for a SI or PS applicant, was that after January 1, 2017 there would no longer be a path to licensure by experience only. Their qualifications would be based upon a combination of education and experience. Every surveyor's qualifications are unique and if you have any questions about the different paths to licensure please feel free to contact the Board staff.

- **Arkansas State Specific Surveyor Exam**

There is no change to the Part 1 and Part 2 exam schedule for the Arkansas State Specific Exams offered in paper and pencil at the State Fair Grounds in October 27, 2017 and April 13, 2018. Please contact the Board office for more information.

- **NCEES Exams in Computer-Based Testing (CBT) Format.**

Many NCEES exams are already administered in CBT format. They are the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE), Fundamentals of Surveying (FS), and Principles and Practice of Surveying (PS) exams.

Effective January 2, 2018 the NCEES Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) Chemical exam will also be administered in CBT format. .

The CBT format allows for year round testing at a Pearson Vue test center and gives examinees the freedom to pick the exam time, date and location. Examinees are provided an exam specific electronic copy of the NCEES Reference Handbook which is the only reference material that can be used during the exam. Examinees usually receive their results 7-10 days after the exam. For more information on registering for CBT exams or what to expect on exam day, download the [NCEES Examinee Guide](#).

- **NCEES Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) Exams**

NCEES announced that there will be changes to the following exams effective April 2018: Architectural Engineering, Electrical and Computer, Environmental, Structural 16-hour, and Civil-Construction and Structural modules. Visit <https://ncees.org/engineering/> for more details.

News and Updates

NCEES launched a new full service database on June 20, 2016. According to NCEES, the MyNCEES was designed to focus on their customers, whether state licensure boards or examinees. From the website, the customer is able to register for exams, download/purchase exam prep materials, apply for an NCEES Record, develop a licensing record, or credentials evaluated for a board.

This year's NCEES Annual Meeting was held in Miami Beach, Florida on August 23-26, 2017. The Arkansas Board was well represented by Vice President Brian Moore, David Beasley and Ivan Hoffman. Some of the highlights of the meeting include reduction in FE and FS exam prices beginning in 2018, decoupling exams and licensure, and the development of a NCEES U.S. Public Lands Survey System (PLSS) exam module.

Due to the success of the Computer Based Test (CBT) fundamentals exams and the Principles and Practice of Surveying examination, NCEES has notified the Board that they are in the process of converting all exams to CBT. NCEES will offer the first CBT for the Principles and Practice of Engineering Chemical examination in January 2018. This exam will now be offered year round with 4 test cycles. The remaining NCEES Principles and Practice Engineering exams will be offered paper and pencil at the state fairgrounds October 27th-28th, 2017.
