DISMISSAL ORDER

The Arkansas Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") registered a complaint on November 1, 2010, charging Harrison Engineering, LLC (AR-COA #2155, hereinafter "Harrison Engineering") with providing or offering to provide engineering services in Arkansas as a firm without a Certificate of Authorization from the Board, in violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-303(a)(1)(C).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Harrison Engineering was issued Certificate of Authorization #2155 to offer and provide engineering services in Arkansas on October 25, 2010.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds no violation by Harrison Engineering.

ORDER

Based on these Findings and Conclusions, the complaint against Harrison Engineering is dismissed.
