FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

A hearing on the above-referenced matter was held before the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission (“AMVC”) on June 16, 2021 at the Arkansas Department of Labor and Licensing, 900 West Capitol Avenue, Little Rock, Arkansas 72201. A representative of the Respondent, Taylor Made Ambulance, did not appear, although properly served with the Notice of Hearing. Assistant Attorney General Juliane Chavis appeared on behalf of the AMVC.

Finding proper notice had been given Respondent, the AMVC, from all the evidence presented, makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Taylor Made Ambulance, located at 3704 Medallion Place, Newport, AR, was a second stage manufacturer formerly licensed to sell Dodge, Ford, Freightliner, GM, International, and Sprinter Ambulances.
2. Taylor Made Ambulance’s license expired on June 30, 2020.
3. On August 6, 2020, AMVC License Supervisor Robert Galloway notified Taylor Made Ambulance that its manufacturer license had expired.
4. Taylor Made Ambulance currently has not dealers.
5. As of May 11, 2021, Taylor Made Ambulance had not renewed its license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Motor vehicle manufacturers, distributors, and representatives are required to conform their conduct to the AMVC Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-101, *et seq.*, and the rules promulgated by the AMVC pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-204.
2. According to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-301, it is unlawful for a person to engage in business as a new vehicle manufacturer without obtaining a license from AMVC.
3. All applications for licenses shall be accompanied by the appropriate fees in accordance with the schedule set out in Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-303.
4. Failure to comply with any provision of the AMVC Act or any rule promulgated by the AMVC may result in revocation or suspension of the license per Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-308(a)(4), (5), and (19), or may result in a monetary penalty in lieu of revocation or suspension as set out in Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-309.
5. Taylor Made Ambulance violated Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-308 by failing to comply with provisions of the AMVC Act, failing to maintain the qualifications for a license, and failing to renew its manufacturer's license as set out in Findings of Fact 1 through 5 above.

ORDER

1. The manufacturer's license of Taylor Made Ambulance is hereby terminated.
2. Pursuant to the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-212, Respondent may petition for judicial review of this decision by filing a petition in the Circuit Court in the county in which he resides or does business or in the Circuit Court of Pulaski County within thirty (30) days after service of this order.
