

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

The scheduled Education & Training Grant Subcommittee meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order via conference call at 9:00 a.m. by Chair Joy Blankenship. Staff present included Sandy Stroope and Crystal Campbell. The Subcommittee members present on the call were Commissioners Duane Neal, Scott Wood, Mitch Ward, and Rick Whitten.

Crystal Campbell presented the Education & Training Grant applications for the 2021 fiscal year to the subcommittee for recommendation of funding. Following the review, Chairman Blankenship accepted a proper motion and a second to the Subcommittee recommendations for funding. Recommendations will be presented to the Commission for approval during the upcoming regularly scheduled Commission meeting set for Wednesday, April 21, 2021.

The recommended institutions for funding are as follows: ASU Three Rivers, \$13,500; ASUB- Automotive Technology, \$23,500; ASUB- Diesel Technology, \$15,000; Cabot High School, \$13,500; East Arkansas Community College \$12,552.17; Huntsville High School, \$13,500; National Park College, \$10,633; North Arkansas College, \$13,500; Northwest Technical Institution, -Automotive Technology, \$15,202.50; South Arkansas Community College, \$8,093; UA Fort Smith, \$9,708; UA Pulaski Technical College, \$14,000; UACCM, \$9,842.55; Waldron High School, \$13,929.52.

Chairman Blankenship accepted a proper motion and a second to adjourn the meeting.
