

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order via conference call at 9:30a.m. by Chair Joy Blankenship. Staff present included Sandy Stroope, Tanelle Hymes, Crystal Campbell, and John Carmack. All the Commissioners were on the call except for Duane Neal. Also present on the call was Julie Chavis with the Attorney General's Office.

The minutes from the August 19, 2020, meeting was unanimously approved following a proper motion and second.

The Commission approved the meeting expenses for the current meeting following a proper motion and second.

Julie Chavis with the Attorney General's Office informed the Commission that the appeal process has not expired on the current Ad Hoc findings/actions from a previous hearing that included Ford Motor Company and Crain Family Holdings, LLC. in Circuit Court. And we are still waiting to get correspondence.

The Commission then reviewed and approved Consent Orders H#20-012 Sherp of the South, LLC, H#20-013 R.V. City 1 LLC, H#20-020 Presidential Conversions, Inc., as presented.

Director Stroope updated the Commission that we are officially moved in at 900 W. Capitol Ave., Suite 400, Little Rock, AR 72201. Director Stroope also made the Commission aware of the budget hearings that are taking place and that he will fill everyone in as more information comes along.
