**FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board on July 26, 2024, at the Boards offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, AGSOLAR LLC was properly notified and did not appear. The Board was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Dewey Watson served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Board makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. AGSOLAR LLC was licensed by the Contractors Licensing Board but that license expired on March 31, 2024.

2. Our office received a complaint from James DePriest against AGSOLAR LLC alleging he had abandoned a project. Despite repeated requests by mail and email AGSOLAR LLC failed or refused to respond to the allegations in the complaint. AGSOLAR LLC was licensed when the complaint was received and at the time the work was performed.

3. Regulation 224-25-8(b) requires a licensed contractor to cooperate with an investigation and states that failure to do so can be considered misconduct and result in the revocation of the contractor's license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


AGSOLAR LLC is guilty of violating Section 17-25-308, misconduct in the conduct of the contractor's business.

ORDER

The Board voted unanimously that the license of AGSOLAR LLC is revoked for misconduct. AGSOLAR LLC shall refrain from bidding on or performing work on any projects in the amount of \$50,000.00 or more prior to being licensed with the Contractors Licensing Board. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 25-15-212.
