**FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board on January 23, 2026, at the Board's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, CHARLES BULLOCK, d/b/a ROCKIN IV ENTERPRISES was properly notified and did not appear. The Board was represented by James D. Lawson, Administrator. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Board makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. CHARLES BULLOCK, d/b/a ROCKIN IV ENTERPRISES has undertaken the position of contractor as defined in Section 17-25-101 (Act 150 of 1965 as amended) and Section 17-25-401 (Act 162 of 1987 as amended), **New Shop Build in Texarkana, AR.**
2. CHARLES BULLOCK, d/b/a ROCKIN IV ENTERPRISES is not licensed by the Contractors Licensing Board.
3. CHARLES BULLOCK, d/b/a ROCKIN IV ENTERPRISES has failed to obtain a \$10,000.00 surety bond or cash bond prior to commencing work as a contractor.
4. CHARLES BULLOCK, d/b/a ROCKIN IV ENTERPRISES entered into a contract with Bill Duffer to erect a metal building for commercial use for \$64,414. There were 13 days on the project.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

CHARLES BULLOCK, d/b/a ROCKIN IV ENTERPRISES is guilty of violating Section 17-25-103, Act 150 of 1965, as amended. (See Act 180 of 1985.)


CHARLES BULLOCK, d/b/a ROCKIN IV ENTERPRISES is guilty of violating Section 17-25-408 for failing to comply with the bonding requirements as set out in Section 17-25-404. (See Act 162 of 1987.)

ORDER

The Board voted unanimously that CHARLES BULLOCK, d/b/a ROCKIN IV ENTERPRISES shall pay a civil penalty of \$1,932 for violation of Act 150; \$3,220 for violation of Act 162 as amended for a total of \$5,152.00 to the Board, payable within twenty (20) days of receipt of this Order and refrain from bidding on or performing work on any projects in the amount of \$50,000.00 or more prior to being licensed with the Contractors Licensing Board and obtaining a \$10,000.00 surety bond or cash bond as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 17-25-401, *et seq.* You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 25-15-212.

**FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board on January 23, 2026, at the Boards offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, CHAMPION RESTORATION LLC was properly notified and did not appear. The Board was represented by James D. Lawson, Administrator. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Board makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. CHAMPION RESTORATION LLC has an expired commercial contractors license and a pending renewal application.
2. Our office was contacted by the City of Cabot regarding a contractors license that had been presented to them by CHAMPION RESTORATION LLC. They asked our office to verify the license. Upon examination the license was fraudulent and we notified the City of that and that CHAMPION RESTORATION LLC was not licensed to perform commercial or residential projects.
3. CHAMPION RESTORATION LLC has 6 complaints and thre previous violations, all of which have been resolved.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

CHAMPION RESTORATION LLC is guilty of violating Section 17-25-308, Act 150, as amended. (See Act 180 of 1985.)

ORDER

The Board voted unanimously that CHAMPION RESTORATION LLC is guilty of misconduct and shall pay a civil penalty of \$500 and that a letter of reprimand should be issued to them. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 25-15-212.

ORDER

A meeting on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board on January 23, 2026, at the Board's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas, Appellant appealing the denial of a license by the Residential Contractors Committee. Appellant James McDonald, d/b/a BBKF Enterprises, LLC, did not appear. The Board was represented by James D. Lawson, Administrator. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer.


1. James McDonald, d/b/a BBKF Enterprises, LLC was charged with performing work without a license in violation of Ark. Code Ann. §17-25-505.
2. The Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee held a hearing on June 25, 2025, concerning the alleged violations of James McDonald, d/b/a BBKF Enterprises, LLC.
3. The Committee found James McDonald, d/b/a BBKF Enterprises, LLC in violation of §17-25-505, as amended and issued a civil penalty in the amount of \$80,000 and issued a cease and desist order to prevent the contractor from performing work in violation.
4. James McDonald, d/b/a BBKF Enterprises, LLC timely appealed the decision of the Residential Committee to the Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board.
5. Upon review of the record and testimony, the Board finds that there was substantial evidence to support the finding of a violation and affirmed the decision of the Residential Committee.

WHEREFORE, by a unanimous vote the Board does affirm the finding of a violation and affirms the decision of the Residential Committee of a violation of Ark Code Ann §17-25-505, a civil penalty in the amount of \$80,000, and the issuance of a cease and desist order. James McDonald, d/b/a BBKF Enterprises, LLC is ordered to pay to the Residential Contractors Committee the cost of the transcript, \$320.00. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-409.

WHEREFORE, after reviewing the briefs, transcript, and evidence, by a unanimous vote the Board does affirm the finding of the Residential Committee from June 25, 2025. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-409.
