
1. The Department of Labor is authorized to impose civil money penalties for such violations pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 17-28-309.



SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into on the 29th day of September, 2007 between the Arkansas Department of Labor (hereinafter, ADL) and Kenneth Eckert. Specifically, the parties agree as follows:


1. The Arkansas Department of Labor has the authority to administer and enforce the provisions of the State Electrical Code as adopted by the Board of Electrical Examiners (hereinafter, Board) pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 20-31-104(f).
2. Kenneth Eckert has been licensed by the Board as a Master Electrician, license number M-7772. This license expired August 31, 2007.
3. Kenneth Eckert was denied renewal of his licenses due to an outstanding civil money penalty in the amount of \$2,166.67 assessed on February 8, 2007.
4. Kenneth Eckert was assessed a subsequent civil money penalty in the amount of \$9000.00 on May 29, 2007. Mr. Eckert timely contested that penalty and has requested a hearing before the Board. No final administrative determination has been made on this penalty.
5. Kenneth Eckert shall pay the civil money penalty in the amount of \$2,166.67 pursuant to the terms of the Promissory Note executed simultaneously with this Agreement and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.
6. The Arkansas Department of Labor shall renew the licenses of Kenneth Eckert, upon payment of standard renewal fees, although such licenses shall expire on February 29,

2008. The Arkansas Department of Labor agrees to renew Kenneth Eckert's license at that time until August 31, 2008, provided Kenneth Eckert has paid the civil money penalty in full pursuant to the attached Promissory Note and Kenneth Eckert has no further disciplinary actions or violations or fines finalized and due and owing as of February 29, 2007. The parties both recognize that the \$9000.00 penalty which is pending may or may not be upheld by the Board sometime prior to February 29, 2007 and may result in Kenneth Eckert's license not being renewed at that time. There will be no additional renewal fee for any period of licensure from February 29, 2008 through August 31, 2008.

7. This Agreement shall not be construed as limiting the Department of Labor or the Board of Electrical Examiners from taking any disciplinary action or imposing any fine for any matter unrelated to this Agreement, including the pending penalty of \$9000.00 assessed May 29, 2007.

8. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes and cancels any and all other agreements between the parties relating to the subject matter hereof.




EXHIBIT A

PROMISSORY NOTE

7. This Agreement resolves all issues between the parties with respect to the civil money penalty issued October 9, 2006 and the denial of license renewal on or about July 31, 2007.



FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. Robert Snell is a principal of Snell-Northcutt Electric, Inc., an electrical contractor. Robert Snell is the qualifying master electrician for the company on the company's contractor license with the Contractor's Licensing Board.

2. On March 5, 2007, the Department of Labor conducted an inspection on a new construction job located at 4 Michelle Lane, Little Rock, AR. Snell-Northcutt Electric, Inc. was the electrical contractor on the job. Electrical work was being performed on this project on March 5, 2007, at 3:00 p.m. by an unsupervised apprentice of Snell-Northcutt Electric, Inc., Peter R. Porter, who is registered with license number EA-4124.

3. The Department of Labor assessed Robert Snell with a civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) and served notice of proposed disciplinary action by certified mail on April 18, 2007.

4. This fine is a third offense fine for Robert Snell. On September 3, 2005, Robert Snell was assessed a civil money penalty in the amount of \$150 for failure to supervise 2 apprentices. Robert Snell did not contest the penalty. On October 5, 2005, Robert Snell was assessed a civil money penalty in the amount of \$550.00 for employing one (1) unlicensed individual to perform electrical work and failure to supervise 4 apprentices. Robert Snell did not contest the penalty.

5. 2. The board is authorized to revoke or suspend a license for cause pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 17-28-202(a)(3). The board is authorized to impose civil money penalties pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §17-28-309.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Robert Snell shall pay a civil money penalty in the amount of \$1000.00 and in lieu of suspension or revocation shall be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years, dating from entry of this order, and that during this time, Robert Snell shall report in advance the date and location of any electrical work performed by Snell-Northcutt Electric, Inc. in Arkansas to the Chief Electrical

This matter came before the Board of Electrical Examiners, State of Arkansas ("Board") on Tuesday, January 16, 2007 at 1:00 p.m. in the offices of the Arkansas Department of Labor. Allen Shaver was not present, although the Board finds that he received notice of the hearing by regular mail. Daniel Faulkner, counsel for the Department of Labor represented the agency and presented the staff's case for revocation. Chairman Gary Ferrell presided over the hearing.

The Board makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. Allen Shaver ("Shaver") applied for a grandfather master license June 20, 1998. The application was accompanied by a letter from Fleming Electric indicating Shaver's work experience and was signed by a Cindy Gray ("Gray").
2. Based on Shaver's application and letter verifying experience, the Board approved the application and Shaver was granted a master license.
3. Chief Electrical Inspector Charles Covington ("Covington") testified that he received information in February 2006 from Conway City Inspector Paul

Young that Shaver had not been an employee of Fleming Electric. Covington then interviewed Rhonda Burton ("Burton"), Office Manager of Fleming Electric, to determine the validity of the original application information. Burton sent Covington correspondence that indicates that neither Shaver nor Gray was ever employed by Fleming Electric. Based on this information, Covington recommended to Labor Code Enforcement Administrator Ron Baker ("Baker") that Shaver's license be revoked for cause due to the falsification involved in the application process.

4. Burton testified that upon being contacted by Covington, she checked Fleming records and found no record of either Shaver or Gray being employed by Fleming Electric. She then sent Covington a letter stating her findings. Further, she pointed out that the letterhead used in the original letter is not consistent with Fleming's letterhead. She further testified that no one at Fleming had any knowledge of Shaver or Gray being employed there.

5. Baker testified that upon receiving Covington's recommendation for revocation, he approved of the action and that notice of this revocation hearing was sent via certified and regular mail to Shaver's last known address on December 15, 2006. Baker further testified that the agency has not received the certified mail receipt at this time and that the regular mail notice has not returned.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The Board of Electrical Examiners is authorized to revoke or suspend any license for cause. Ark. Code Ann. § 17-28-202(a)(3)(Repl. 2001). In the present

case, the Board concludes that Allen Shaver submitted false information to the Agency and Board in order to obtain a master electrician license.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the journeyman license of Allen Shaver, M-7131, is hereby revoked for cause.

FINDINGS OF FACT:


