

2. The Department of Labor notified Gary Williams of a civil penalty assessment in the amount of **\$450.00** for these violations.


3. Gary Williams has not been previously disciplined or fined by the Board.


4. Gary Williams specifically agrees to future compliance with Arkansas laws regarding licensing of electricians and the standards for the performance of electrical work.
