Department of Labor and Licensing (ADLL) Report –

- Board Appointments/Reappointments –
Brian Moore PE Member and Tom Scott Consumer Member positions expired June 30, 2023; Dave Beasley PE Member and Rod Williams PE, PS Member positions expired June 30, 2024; Murry Cline PE Member and Kyle Salyer PE Members positions expired June 30, 2025).
- Legislative Audit's FY24 Internal Control & Compliance Assessment of ADLL began February 4, 2025. Board Meeting minutes were requested August 25, 2025.
- The Office of Property Risk – As per Act 560 of 2025 and Act 779 of 2025, the building located at 623 Woodlane has a new insurance state agency administrator, the Office of Property Risk. This change is due to the state desiring to be self-insured. Cyber Risk Insurance is still with AMAIT-Department of Insurance. The total Annual Premium for the building is \$1,781.98. The value of the building is \$761,058.52 with a \$250,000 deductible, and personal property contents (valued at \$223,353.30) also has a \$250,000 deductible.

Justin Hall v Board appeal 60CV-23-8986 – Justin W. Hall & Hall Engineering, LTD filed a Petition for Review and Stay of an Order of Board on 11/27/2023. Case is still open. Justin Hall passed away 9/1/2025.

Ashley Bice v Board appeal 60CV-24-3019 – Ashley Bice filed a Petition for Review and Stay of an Order of Board on 04/16/2024 and the Board's response was filed on May 17, 2024. The case is still open.

AR FOIA amendments – Act 505 of 2025 amended the provisions of the FOIA concerning public meetings. Future training will be available.

Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders announced revised work policies for all state agencies. Including: State Office Business Hours Policy 70, office hours to be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; Remote Work Policy 71, standards for working remotely; Alternative and Flexible Work Schedule Policy 72, best practices for alternative and flexible work arrangements; Infant at Work Program Policy 73, infants (4 wks. - 6 mos.) may be brought to work; and Meeting Policy 74, prioritizing face-to-face interactions; and Email Signature Policy 1.0 and Email Signature Standard 1.0, standardizes the email signature block format.

RE: 2025 NCEES Annual Meeting Report

The 2025 National Council of Exams for Engineers and Surveyors (NCEES) Annual Meeting was held August 18-22, 2025 in New Orleans, Louisiana. Three (3) Board Members (Dr. Dave Beasley PE, Keith Sikes PS, and Kyle Salyer PE, PS) and two (2) staff members (Heather Richardson and Grant Grigg) attended the meeting. All attendees were NCEES paid delegates to the meeting, no cost to the state.

The first full day of the meeting gives the members the opportunity to earn continuing education or PDHs. The programs are divided into engineers, surveyors, and Member Board Administrators (MBA). The program includes:

- International Updates from ABET and NCEES
ABET CEO Michael Milligan provided an update on ABET's latest initiatives, programs, and events, including international efforts such as the Washington Accord. NCEES International Engagement Strategist Marie Nebesky shared the latest developments in the NCEES international activities and update on the US and UK MRA.
- Practice Overlap: Using the Interorganizational Council on Regulation (ICOR) Resource
Incidental practice or overlapping practice is a challenge for licensing boards and practitioners. ICOR provided a collaborative document (NCEES, NCARB, CLARB, and CIDQ) that will assist licensing boards and practitioners to ensure the practitioner is competent to practice engineering or surveying.
- Colonial States Board of Surveyor Registration Meeting
- Structural Engineering Caucus
This was a forum to examine issues related to structural engineering.
- AI at the Crossroads: Industry Trends and NCEES Applications
David Yunger CEO of AI Strategy from Vaital presented an overview of current AI technologies, implementation strategies, and industry transformations for engineers and surveyors.
- Advocating for the Boards Amid Deregulatory Trends
Josh Twitty, NCEES Advocacy and External Engagement Strategist updated on recent legislative session trends and licensing reform efforts. The discussion was mostly about Florida.
- Understanding Exam Development
Lehmon Dekle, NCEES Chief Officer of Examinations discussed the life cycle of exams including the development of new exams.
- MBA Outreach
Nina Norris NCEES Chief Communications Officer led discussions on how member boards can elevate outreach efforts and how NCEES can assist.
- Plenary Session
Andrew Zoutewelle PLS and Davy McDowell PE NCEES CEO discussed the upcoming topics before the NCEES Council at the annual meeting.

The next two (2) days were divided into business sessions, zone meetings, and professional forums. All NCEES delegates are required to attend all business sessions. During the business sessions the Council which is made up of all member boards (69 states and jurisdictions), listened to all the NCEES staff reports and committee reports, discussed motions, and voted on various motions that affect the Council. The Oklahoma Board brought a ACCA procedure motion from the floor for discussion and voting. It was voted down. The Virginia Board brought a motion from the floor for discussion and voting, regarding adding an MBA position to the NCEES Board of Directors. The motion was referred to the MBA Committee for further development.

The Southern Zone meeting thanked the AR Board for hosting a great meeting this year in Little Rock, AR. and discussed the reports and motions on the agenda for the Business Sessions. The Southern Zone did not make a motion from the floor this year.

The MBA Forum discussed NCEES Updates (ELVS database, records, credentials evaluations, MRA, etc.), Oklahoma Board ACCA Motion; Engineering Education Standard Committee Motion; Florida legislative session; Motion to add MBA to the NCEES Board of Director's; and AI issues/problems the states are seeing regarding non-engineered designs/plans and non-surveyed plats/surveys, fake/stolen signatures/seals, and the fraud being facilitated by "work-for-hire" websites.

The Law Enforcement Forum discussed current law enforcement issues affecting member boards including "work-for-hire" websites, theft of seals, and AI issues.

The last day of the meeting was dedicated to the NCEES Board of Director's Meeting and Law Enforcement Workshop. This year the Law Enforcement Workshop focus was Safety Awareness Training. The Code Enforcement Officer Safety Foundation taught safety awareness training to include the threat, basic investigator safety, and high-risk case management.
