

ASPS Proposed Draft ACA §17-48-203(b)

(b) Effective January 1, 2017, an applicant for licensure as a professional surveyor shall qualify under one (1) of the following provisions:

(1) (A) A graduate holding a baccalaureate degree from a curriculum of four (4) years or more who has completed at least thirty (30) semester credit hours or the equivalent, as approved by the board, in courses involving land surveying, mapping, and real property, as approved by the board, followed by along with three (3) years or more of experience in responsible charge of land surveying under the supervision of a professional surveyor, of which a minimum of one and a half (1.5) years must follow the date of the conferment of the degree, and who has passed an examination for certification as a surveyor intern shall be admitted to sit for a written examination in a form approved by the board.

(B) An applicant who is otherwise qualified shall be granted licensure as a professional surveyor upon passing the written examination; or

(2) (A) A graduate holding an associate of science degree in surveying or an associate of applied science in surveying degree from a program approved by the board or its equivalent, as approved by the board, followed by along with six (6) years or more of experience in responsible charge of land surveying under the supervision of a professional surveyor, of which a minimum of three (3) years must follow the date of conferment of the degree, and who has passed an examination for certification as a surveyor intern shall be admitted to sit for a written examination in a form approved by the board.

(B) An applicant who is otherwise qualified shall be granted licensure as a professional surveyor upon passing the written examination.
