The Meeting recessed at 11:45 AM and President Sikes reconvened the meeting at 1:00 PM (Member Perry absent).



- Reinstatement – Approved by motion made (Beasley moved, Cline seconded) and carried.


Closing instructions were provided and the Hearing record was closed.
