**FINDINGS OF FACT,  
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

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A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee on April 22, 2026, at the Committee's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, BRANCH GROUP LLC was properly notified and did not appear. The Committee was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Committee makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. BRANCH GROUP LLC holds a residential roofer registration from the Residential Contractors Committee

2. Our office received a complaint from Shayne Sandine against BRANCH GROUP LLC stating that they had entered into a contract with BRANCH GROUP LLC to apply a Perma Kote for \$7,500. The work performed was very poor and BRANCH GROUP LLC would not return to repair the work or refund any of the money.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


BRANCH GROUP LLC is guilty of violating Section 17-25-510(c) misconduct in the contractors business.

**ORDER**

The Committee voted unanimously that the roofer registration of BRANCH GROUP LLC is revoked for misconduct. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against BRANCH GROUP LLC to prevent them from performing work in violation. BRANCH GROUP LLC shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.

**FINDINGS OF FACT,  
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

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A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee on April 22, 2026, at the Committee's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, ERIC HOLMES was properly notified and did not appear. The Committee was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Committee makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. ERIC HOLMES has undertaken the position of residential contractor as defined in Section 17-25-505, **Home Improvement in Little Rock, AR.**
2. ERIC HOLMES is not licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee.
3. Our office received a complaint from Kimberly J Chapman Titus against ERIC HOLMES stating that she had paid him \$2,750 to build a fence. Some work was performed but the project was abandoned prior to completion. ERIC HOLMES did not return any of the money. There were 6 days of activity on the project.
4. ERIC HOLMES has 3 previous violations for working without a contractors license and owes penalties in the amount of \$28,400 that have never been paid.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


ERIC HOLMES is guilty of violating Section 17-25-505, as amended.

**ORDER**

The Committee voted unanimously that ERIC HOLMES shall pay a civil penalty of \$400 per day for 6 days activity for a total of \$2,600 for violation of Section 17-25-505 payable to the Committee within twenty (20) days. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against ERIC HOLMES to prevent them from performing work in violation. ERIC HOLMES shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.
