BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS

Case #2008-21, in the matter of Achala Services:

COMPLAINT

The Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") received a complaint on June 18, 2008, charging Achala Services (non-registrant, hereinafter "Achala") with offering to provide engineering services in Arkansas without a valid Certificate of Authorization, in violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-303(a)(1)(C).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On May 8, 2008, Tommy Bond (AR-PE #2219) received an e-mail message from Umesh, on behalf of Achala Services. In part, that message stated: "We are Civil Engineers team in India. We hold an Estimation Consultancy firm in India. We offers Quantity take off service for Contractors, Architect and Engineering firms . . ."
 - 2. Estimation and quantity take-off are not strictly regarded as engineering services.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds Achala's actions as described in the Findings of Fact do not constitute a violation of the statutes or rules governing the Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors.

<u>ORDER</u>

Based on these findings, the complaint against Achala is dismissed without further action by the Board.
