BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF LICENSURE FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND PROFESSIONAL SURVEYORS

Case #2008-35, in the matter of Anthony Anderson:

COMPLAINT

The Arkansas Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") registered a complaint on September 22, 2008, charging Anthony P. Anderson (AR-PS #1272, hereinafter "Anderson") with professional misconduct, in the form of false statements, in violation of Article I.D of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Complainant bought a parcel in Franklin County out of foreclosure. There was no survey as part of the purchase.
- 2. On or about June 30, 2008, Anderson's office was contacted by telephone by the Complainant about having a survey of the property performed. Anderson provided a price for the survey during a subsequent telephone contact.
- 3. There is a dispute about whether an agreement to perform the survey was made at that stage, even though there was no written agreement.
 - 4. The survey was subsequently performed, and the Complainant refused to pay.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds Anderson's actions as described in the Findings of Fact do not constitute a violation of the statutes or rules governing the Arkansas Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors.

ORDER

Based on these findings, the complaint against Anderson is dismissed without further action by the Board.
