BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS

Case # 2008-07, in the matter of Richard J. Cotton:

DISCIPLINARY HEARING

On September 8, 2008, the Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") held a formal hearing to consider the above-referenced matter. Finding proper notice had been given the Respondent, the Board, from all evidence presented, makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Respondent is not now nor has he ever been a registered Professional Engineer in the State of Arkansas.
- 2. On 3/17/08, the Respondent sent an e-mail to his subordinates specifying and scheduling certain tasks. The e-mail was closed by the notation "Jeff Cotton P.E. B.S.E.E."

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

These actions by the Respondent constitute one violation of Arkansas Code

Annotated §17-30-102(b), (representing oneself as an engineer without being a registrant of
the Board), actionable by the Board against non-registrants under the provisions of Arkansas

Code Annotated §17-30-305(e).

ORDER

Based on the foregoing, it is ordered that Respondent pay a \$2,000 civil penalty for the violation to the Board within fifty (50) days of the service of this Order.
