A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee on September 25, 2024, at the Committee's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, JAMES CARVILL was properly notified and did not appear. The Committee was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Dewey Watson served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Committee makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. JAMES CARVILL has undertaken the position of residential contractor as defined in Section 17-25-505, **Home Improvement in Benton, AR.**
2. JAMES CARVILL is not licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee.
3. Our office received a complaint against JAMES CARVILL from Megan Maulden stating she had hired him to perform a home improvement project for \$4,200. The work was very poor and the contractor eventually refunded \$1,300 to Ms. Maulden. There were 30 days of activity on this project.
4. JAMES CARVILL has a previous violation from November 2020 in the amount of \$80,800. The Committee also has a judgment against JAMES CARVILL in that amount and has obtained an injunction.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

JAMES CARVILL is guilty of violating Section 17-25-505, as amended.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that JAMES CARVILL shall pay a civil penalty of \$400 per day for 30 days of activity for a total of \$12,000 for violation of Section 17-25-505 payable to the Committee within twenty (20) days. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against JAMES CARVILL to prevent them from performing work in violation. JAMES CARVILL shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.

2. NIVO SOLAR LLC is not licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee.
3. Our office received a complaint from Monty Anderson against NIVO SOLAR LLC stating that he had hired the company to install solar panels for \$43,955. The solar panels were not producing as much as he was told at the time he bought them. There were 50 days of activity on this project.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


NIVO SOLAR LLC is guilty of violating Section 17-25-505, as amended.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that NIVO SOLAR LLC shall pay a civil penalty of \$100 per day for 50 days for a total of \$5,000 for violation of Section 17-25-505. This amount is reduced to \$3,000 if NIVO SOLAR LLC is licensed within 60 days NIVO SOLAR LLC shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

WHITES GENERAL CONTRACTING & ELECTRICAL SERVICES, LLC is guilty of violating Section 17-25-505, as amended.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that WHITES GENERAL CONTRACTING & ELECTRICAL SERVICES, LLC shall pay a civil penalty of \$400 per day for 20 days of activity for a total of \$8,000 for violation of Section 17-25-505 payable to the Committee within twenty (20) days. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against WHITES GENERAL CONTRACTING & ELECTRICAL SERVICES, LLC to prevent them from performing work in violation. WHITES GENERAL CONTRACTING & ELECTRICAL SERVICES, LLC shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. The contractor began work but failed to complete the project or return any of the money. The work that was performed was poor and structurally unstable. There were 12 days of activity on the project.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


RANDALL NORWOOD, d/b/a NORWOOD MASONRY & LANDCAPING DESIGN LLC is guilty of violating Section 17-25-505, as amended.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that RANDALL NORWOOD, d/b/a NORWOOD MASONRY & LANDCAPING DESIGN LLC shall pay a civil penalty of \$400 per day for 12 days of activity for a total of \$4,800 for violation of Section 17-25-505 payable to the Committee within twenty (20) days. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against RANDALL NORWOOD, d/b/a NORWOOD MASONRY & LANDCAPING DESIGN LLC to prevent them from performing work in violation. RANDALL NORWOOD, d/b/a NORWOOD MASONRY & LANDCAPING DESIGN LLC shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. JAMES R. REAVIS, d/b/a REAVIS DESIGNS is guilty of violating Section 17-25-510(c), misconduct in the contractors business.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that the license of JAMES R. REAVIS, d/b/a REAVIS DESIGNS is revoked for misconduct. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against JAMES R. REAVIS, d/b/a REAVIS DESIGNS to prevent them from performing work in violation. JAMES R. REAVIS, d/b/a REAVIS DESIGNS shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. 

MASHAN HOWARTH shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against BENTLEY'S PAINTING to prevent them from performing work in violation. BENTLEY'S PAINTING shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. 
CALVIN LEE, d/b/a LEE'S RECONSTRUCTION is guilty of violating Section 17-25-510(c), misconduct in the contractors business.
