ORDER

A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board on June 27, 2025, at the Board's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Appellant, KENNY EVERETT, D/B/A KJE CONSTRUCTION, did not appear. The Board was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Dewey Watson served as Hearing Officer. From a review of the transcript and considering the arguments of the parties, Board finds as follows:

1. KENNY EVERETT, D/B/A KJE CONSTRUCTION was charged with performing work without a license in violation of Ark. Code Ann. §17-25-505
2. The Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee held a hearing on February 26, 2025, concerning the alleged violations of KENNY EVERETT, D/B/A KJE CONSTRUCTION.
3. The Committee found KENNY EVERETT, D/B/A KJE CONSTRUCTION in violation of §17-25-505, as amended and issued a civil penalty in the amount of \$47,200 and issued a cease and desist order to prevent the contractor from performing work in violation.
4. KENNY EVERETT, D/B/A KJE CONSTRUCTION timely appealed the decision of the Residential Committee to the Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board.
5. Upon review of the record, the Board finds that there was substantial evidence to support the finding of a violation and affirmed the decision of the Residential Committee.

WHEREFORE, by a unanimous vote the Board does affirm the finding of a violation and affirms the decision of the Residential Committee of a civil penalty in the amount of \$47,200 and the issuance of a cease and desist. KENNY EVERETT, D/B/A KJE CONSTRUCTION is ordered to pay to the Residential Contractors Committee the cost of the transcript, \$174.50. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-409.



1. JOHN HARDIN, D/B/A BUILD IT CONSTRUCTION was charged with with misconduct in the contractors business in violation of Ark. Code Ann. §17-25-510(c)(3).
2. The Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee held a hearing on February 26, 2025, concerning the alleged violation of JOHN HARDIN, D/B/A BUILD IT CONSTRUCTION.
3. The Committee found JOHN HARDIN, D/B/A BUILD IT CONSTRUCTION in violation of §17-25-510(c)(3), as amended and revoked the residential remodeler license of JOHN HARDIN, D/B/A BUILD IT CONSTRUCTION.
4. JOHN HARDIN, D/B/A BUILD IT CONSTRUCTION timely appealed the decision of the Residential Committee to the Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board.
5. Upon review of the record, the Board finds that there was substantial evidence to support the finding of a violation and affirmed the decision of the Residential Committee.

WHEREFORE, by a unanimous vote the Board does affirm the finding of a violation and affirms the decision of the Residential Committee. JOHN HARDIN, D/B/A BUILD IT CONSTRUCTION is ordered to pay to the Residential Contractors Committee the cost of the transcript, \$251.50. AGREEMENT OF SETTLEMENT


The Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board ("Board") and ARKANSAS RIVER VALLEY ROOFING AND RESTORATION LLC, d/b/a ARKANSAS RIVER VALLEY ROOFING LLC of RUSSELLVILLE, AR ("ARVR") hereby stipulates and agree as follows:

1. This proceeding was initiated by a homeowner, Ricky Herren, who filed a complaint against ARVR. After investigation, the Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee issued notice for ARVR to appear before it, alleging that ARVR violated the provisions of A.C.A. § 17-25-505 *et seq.*, governing residential contractors, in connection with a roofing project on Herren's residence in Hot Springs, Arkansas. At the conclusion of a hearing, the Committee found a violation by ARVR, and in its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order, revoked ARVR's residential roofing registration. ARVR timely appealed the Committee's Order to the Board.
2. On appeal, after the submission of briefs and argument of counsel for ARVR and counsel for the Board, the Board voted unanimously to affirm the Committee's Order to revoke ARVR's residential roofing registration.
3. In the interest of resolving this matter and avoiding further appeal, ARVR and the Board agree that: (a) The decision of the Committee to revoke the residential roofing registration of ARVR shall be, and it is hereby, REVERSED, based on procedural error; (b) ARVR agrees that it will not attempt to overturn its bond company's payment to the homeowner, Herren; and, (c) ARVR agrees that it will pay the cost of the hearing transcripts, in the amount of \$1,025.00.
4. Upon completion of the terms set forth in paragraph 3 above, the Board shall fully and forever release ARVR from any and all claims arising out of this Notice of Hearing, and ARVR shall have no right of further appeal in connection with said Notice of Hearing.


