CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee on May 13, 2026, at the Committee's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC was properly notified and did appear. The Committee was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Committee makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC is currently licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee as a home improvement contractor with several specialties.

2. In February 2026 BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC received a penalty in the amount of \$4,800 for performing work without a contractors license. His license had expired at the time the work was performed but he renewed the license later. This penalty was payable within 20 days. BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC did not appeal the decision nor did it make any payment toward the penalty despite being sent letters to remind it to do so.

3. Our office received a complaint from Sherri Wood against BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC. Despite repeated requests BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC failed and refused to respond to the complaint.

4. 17 CAR 295-112(b)(1) requires a licensed contractor to cooperate with an investigation and says that the failure to cooperate can be considered misconduct and result in the revocation of a contractors license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC is guilty of violating Section 17-25-510(c) misconduct in the contractor's business.


ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that the license of BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC is revoked for misconduct. This revocation is suspended for 90 days to allow the contractor to pay the previous \$4,800 penalty owed to the Committee, to respond in writing to the complaint filed by Sherri Wood, and to satisfy the complaints filed by Lynette Brown and Sherri Wood. If BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC fails to perform any of these four requirements, its license will be revoked on August 11, 2026; and BURGESS SHELTER KING STORM CELLARS LLC shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor

prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.

2. A complaint was received from John and Susan Walter against HOME MARKETING ASSOCIATES INC, d/b/a PERMA STEEL. Despite repeated requests HOME MARKETING ASSOCIATES INC, d/b/a PERMA STEEL failed or refused to respond to the complaint.
3. 17 CAR 295-112(b)(1) requires a licensed contractor to cooperate with an investigation and says that the failure to cooperate can be considered misconduct and result in the revocation of a contractors license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


HOME MARKETING ASSOCIATES INC, d/b/a PERMA STEEL is guilty of violating Section 17-25-510(c), misconduct in the contractor's business.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that the license of HOME MARKETING ASSOCIATES INC, d/b/a PERMA STEEL is revoked for misconduct. HOME MARKETING ASSOCIATES INC, d/b/a PERMA STEEL shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.

Respondent, MIKE WHITE, d/b/a WOODCHUCK CONSTRUCTION was properly notified and did not appear. The Committee was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Committee makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. MIKE WHITE, d/b/a WOODCHUCK CONSTRUCTION has undertaken the position of residential contractor as defined in Section 17-25-505, **New Residence in Eureka Springs, AR.**
2. MIKE WHITE, d/b/a WOODCHUCK CONSTRUCTION is not licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee.
3. Our office received a complaint from Jeff Spencer against MIKE WHITE, d/b/a WOODCHUCK CONSTRUCTION stating he had entered into a contract with the contractor to build a new residence and install a septic system for an estimated amount of \$120,000 to \$130,000. Mr. Spencer had paid MIKE WHITE, d/b/a WOODCHUCK CONSTRUCTION \$30,000 of this amount before the contractor abandoned the project prior to completion. There were 20 days of activity on the project.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

MIKE WHITE, d/b/a WOODCHUCK CONSTRUCTION is guilty of violating Section 17-25-505, as amended.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that MIKE WHITE, d/b/a WOODCHUCK CONSTRUCTION shall pay a civil penalty of \$400 per day for 20 days of activity for a total of \$8,000 for violation of Section 17-25-505 payable to the Committee within twenty (20) days. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against MIKE WHITE, d/b/a WOODCHUCK CONSTRUCTION to prevent him from performing work in violation. MIKE WHITE, d/b/a WOODCHUCK CONSTRUCTION shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. BORN AGAIN BATHROOMS LLC has undertaken the position of residential contractor as defined in Section 17-25-505, **Home Improvement in Bentonville, AR.**
2. BORN AGAIN BATHROOMS LLC is not licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee.
3. Our office received a complaint from Xinkun Guo against BORN AGAIN BATHROOMS LLC stating that they had paid the contractor \$12,100 to remodel two bathrooms. BORN AGAIN BATHROOMS LLC performed only demolition work and abandoned the project prior to completion, leaving the two bathrooms unusable. There were 40 days of activity on the project.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


BORN AGAIN BATHROOMS LLC is guilty of violating Section 17-25-505, as amended.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that BORN AGAIN BATHROOMS LLC shall pay a civil penalty of \$400 per day for 40 days of activity for a total of \$16,000 for violation of Section 17-25-505 payable to the Committee within twenty (20) days. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against BORN AGAIN BATHROOMS LLC to prevent them from performing work in violation. BORN AGAIN BATHROOMS LLC shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.



SHAWN HICKS, d/b/a FLOOR CHAMPS is guilty of violating Section 17-25-510(c), misconduct in the contractor's business.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that the license of SHAWN HICKS, d/b/a FLOOR CHAMPS is revoked for misconduct. SHAWN HICKS, d/b/a FLOOR CHAMPS shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.
