BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS

IN THE MATTER OF JAMES R. MEHLTRETTER:

STIPULATION AND ORDER

The Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") and James R. Mehltretter (non-registrant, hereinafter "the Respondent"), agree as follows in full settlement of the charges in this disciplinary matter.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Respondent is not now, nor has he ever been, a registered Professional Engineer in Arkansas.
- 2. The Respondent's company, Master Consulting Engineers, Inc, does not now, nor has it ever, held a valid Certificate of Authorization to offer engineering services in Arkansas.
- 3. On December 13, 2007, the Board received an application from the Respondent for Professional Engineering registration by reciprocity.
- 4. In the "NOTICE TO ALL APPLICANTS FOR REINSTATEMENT OR RECIPROCAL REGISTRATION" portion of the application, the Respondent stated in response to Question #1: (The reason you wish to become registered in Arkansas) "We currently have a contract for work in your State."
- 5. In the "NOTICE TO ALL APPLICANTS FOR REINSTATEMENT OR RECIPROCAL REGISTRATION" portion of the application, the Respondent stated in response to Question #4: (Status of plans or reports on any project in Arkansas for which you have been retained as the engineer) "Ready to be signed and sealed."
- 6. The contract referenced in item #4 is for structural engineering services for Regions Bank projects throughout the South. Two such projects are in Arkansas.
- 7. The full text of the "NOTICE TO ALL APPLICANTS FOR REINSTATEMENT OR RECIPROCAL REGISTRATION" from which the statements above are quoted is found as Attachment #1.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The board has jurisdiction over the Respondent and over the subject matter of this proceeding, as provided in Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-305(e).
- 2. The Respondent has been afforded an opportunity to obtain legal counsel and has chosen to proceed *pro se* with the understanding that he is admitting the facts and conduct described above in the Findings of Fact and voluntarily waiving the right to a formal disciplinary hearing.
- 3. The conduct of the Respondent, as set forth above in the Findings of Fact, constitutes one count of practicing or offering to practice engineering in Arkansas without being a registrant of the Board, in violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-102(b), and one count of offering engineering services without a valid Certificate of Authorization, in violation of ACA §17-30-303.

ORDER

1. The Respondent shall pay a \$500.00 civil penalty for each of the violations noted in paragraph #3 of the Conclusions of Law as listed above, for a total civil penalty of \$1,000.00.

2. Payment shall be made to the Board within fifty (50) days of the date this Order is served upon the Respondent.

3. This Stipulation and Order shall be a public record in the custody of the Board.
