**FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee on October 22, 2025, at the Committee's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, RIVER REMODELING LLC was properly notified and did not appear. The Committee was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Committee makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. RIVER REMODELING LLC is licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee as a residential builder.
2. Our office received a complaint from Maurica Williams against RIVER REMODELING LLC. Despite repeated requests the contractor failed or refused to respond to the allegations in the complaint.
3. Our office received a complaint from Keia Fulton against RIVER REMODELING LLC. Despite repeated requests the contractor failed or refuse to respond to the allegations in this complaint.
4. Rule 17 CAR 295-112(b)(1) requires a licensed contractor to cooperate with an investigation and states that failure to do so can be considered misconduct in the contractor's business and result in the revocation of a contractors license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


RIVER REMODELING LLC is guilty of violating Section 17-25-510(c) misconduct in the contractor's business.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that the license of RIVER REMODELING LLC is revoked for misconduct. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against RIVER REMODELING LLC to prevent it from performing work in violation. RIVER REMODELING LLC shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.

**FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee on October 22, 2025, at the Committee's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, ALLEN'S RENOVATIONS & MAINTENANCE LLC was properly notified and Roshun Allen did appear to represent the company. The Committee was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Committee makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. ALLEN'S RENOVATIONS & MAINTENANCE LLC is licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee with a home improvement license with several specialties.

2. Our office received a complaint from Leslie Clement against ALLEN'S RENOVATIONS & MAINTENANCE LLC stating that she had entered into a contract with it to perform a home improvement project for \$18,511. The work that was performed was poor and the contractor abandoned the project prior to completion. The home owner and ALLEN'S RENOVATIONS & MAINTENANCE LLC entered into an agreement with Leslie Clement that the homeowner would be reimbursed \$5,000 on this project. ALLEN'S RENOVATIONS & MAINTENANCE LLC has made sporadic payments to the homeowner and has only reimbursed \$150 at this time.

3. ALLEN'S RENOVATIONS & MAINTENANCE LLC has a previous violation for performing work without a license and entered into a settlement agreement on November 13, 2024, to pay \$12,000 reduced to \$400 if there were no further violations for 3 years. To date he has made two payments totaling \$50 toward this penalty.


4. ALLEN'S RENOVATIONS & MAINTENANCE LLC voluntarily surrendered its contractors license.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously to accept the surrender of ALLEN'S RENOVATIONS & MAINTENANCE LLC license. This will not be considered a violation that will accelerate the previous penalty to the full amount. ALLEN'S RENOVATIONS & MAINTENANCE LLC shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

A hearing on the above captioned matter was held before the Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee on October 22, 2025, at the Committee's offices at 4100 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Respondent, TOP TIER RETAINING WALLS AND LANDSCAPING was properly notified and did not appear. The Committee was represented by Jonathan Hutto, Attorney. Heidi Massey served as Hearing Officer. From testimony and other evidence presented the Committee makes the following findings of fact and conclusion of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. TOP TIER RETAINING WALLS AND LANDSCAPING has undertaken the position of residential contractor as defined in Section 17-25-505, **Home Improvement in Mountain Home, AR.**

2. TOP TIER RETAINING WALLS AND LANDSCAPING is not licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee.

3. Our office received a complaint from Paige Fenske against TOP TIER RETAINING WALLS AND LANDSCAPING stating that she had hired the contractor to perform a home improvement project that including sealing the basement and adding to an existing french drain for \$8,590. After the home received rain, the basement flooded. After this flooding, TOP TIER RETAINING WALLS AND LANDSCAPING hit and broke a water main causing approximately 30,000 gallons of water to be released and flood the basement again while the homeowners were on vacation. The contractor refused to fix the issue and demanded full payment for the project. There were 15 days of activity on the project.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

TOP TIER RETAINING WALLS AND LANDSCAPING is guilty of violating Section 17-25-505, as amended.

ORDER

The Committee voted unanimously that TOP TIER RETAINING WALLS AND LANDSCAPING shall pay a civil penalty of \$400 per day for 15 days of activity for a total of \$6,000 for violation of Section 17-25-505 payable to the Committee within twenty (20) days. The Committee further ordered that a cease and desist order be issued against TOP TIER RETAINING WALLS AND LANDSCAPING to prevent them from performing work in violation. TOP TIER RETAINING WALLS AND LANDSCAPING shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee. You have the right to appeal this decision pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. 17-25-511.
