DISMISSAL ORDER

The Arkansas Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") recorded a complaint on June 23, 2008, charging Clovis W. Satterfield (AR-PS #147, hereinafter "Satterfield") with violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-48-102 (being negligent and/or incompetent in the practice of surveying).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. James C. Smith ("Smith") owns a parcel of land in Crawford County. The survey used to convey the parcel was performed by Satterfield.
2. Satterfield was retained to survey an adjoining property, preparatory to sale.
3. The resulting survey found an overlap of about thirty feet with the boundary line claimed by Smith.
4. The survey of the adjoining property coincided with Satterfield's earlier survey of Smith's parcel.
5. No error by Satterfield was found.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds the conduct by Satterfield described in the Findings of Fact does not warrant further investigation or other action.

ORDER

Based on these findings, the complaint against Satterfield is dismissed.
