BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS

Case #2009-10, in the matter of Shelly Rae West:

COMPLAINT

The Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") registered a complaint on February 10, 2009, charging Shelly Rae West (EI #7084, hereinafter "West"), with practicing and/or offering to practice engineering in Arkansas, in violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-102(b).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On December 20, 2008, the Board received an application from West for original registration as a Professional Engineer.
- 2. When the application was reviewed by the Board on February 10, 2009, West's statements in the experience record of the application suggested she had possibly offered to practice and/or practiced engineering in Arkansas. The staff of the Board was ordered to initiate an investigation into possible violations.
- 3. The investigation found the activities described did not constitute the practice of engineering.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds West's actions as described in the Findings of Fact do not constitute a violation of the statutes or rules governing the Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors.

ORDER

Based on these findings, the complaint against West is dismissed without further action by the Board.
