FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

A hearing on the above-referenced matter was held before the Arkansas Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors ("the Board") on September 13, 2011, at the office of the Board, 623 Woodlane Drive, Little Rock, Arkansas. John Williams, hereinafter referred to as "Respondent," appeared before the Board. On the basis of the testimony and other evidence presented, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- F1. Williams is a Professional Surveyor licensee of the Board, and the Board has jurisdiction over his conduct.
- F2. The survey giving rise to this complaint was a survey bearing Respondent's seal that was provided to Rick and Rebecca Cowden.
- F3. The survey plat was dated August 18, 2008 on the CAD layout of Williams, and bearing Williams' seal and signature.
- F4. The Respondent admitted that his sealed survey dated August 18, 2008 was a preliminary survey which didn't satisfy the Arkansas Minimum Standards for Boundary Surveys because the property corners shown on the survey plat were not set in the field.

F5. The survey provided to the Cowdens does not indicate that it is a preliminary survey.

F6. Everett Rowland, Arkansas State Land Surveyor, advised in a letter dated August 16, 2010 that the survey did not meet the Arkansas Minimum Standards for Boundary Surveys.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

C1. Based on the above Findings of Fact, Respondent is guilty of fraud and deceit in the practice of surveying as set forth in Ark. Code Ann. § 17-48-102(b)(1)(A)(i).

C2. Based on the above Findings of Fact, Respondent is guilty of one count of misconduct in the practice of surveying, in violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 17-48-205.

ORDER

The Respondent's license is hereby REVOKED.

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 25-15-212, the Respondent may petition for judicial review of this decision by filing a petition in the Circuit Court in the county in which he resides or does business or in the Circuit Court of Pulaski County within thirty days after service of this Order.
