BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS

In the matter of Robert Zickwolf, and Case #2008-19:

COMPLAINT

The Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") received a complaint on June 11, 2008, charging Robert W. Zickwolf (PS #661, hereinafter "Zickwolf") with violating the Preamble of the Code of Professional Conduct.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Zickwolf is a Professional Surveyor in Arkansas, and the Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this complaint.
- 2. Zickwolf was retained to survey a property adjoining the family of Bruce Harrod, who brought the complaint.
- 3. Zickwolf had verbal contact with Chris Harrod, the brother of the complainant. According to the complainant, the exchange upset and intimidated the brother.
- 4. Before the investigation of the complaint could be completed, Harrod determined his complaint was without merit, and in a letter to the Board dated July 24, 2008, asked that it be withdrawn.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds Zickwolf's actions as described in the Findings of Fact do not constitute a violation of the statutes or rules governing the Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors.

ORDER

Based on these findings, the complaint against Zickwolf is dismissed without further action by the Board.
