Disciplinary Hearings

June 17, 2025

Case Number: 2024-19, *Wilczek v. America*

Complaint: The Complaint alleged that the Respondent performed engineering without a license.

Resolution: The Board found the Respondent in violation of Ark. Code Ann. §17-30-305(a)(1)(J). A civil penalty of \$5,000 per violation was assessed, for a total penalty of \$20,000.

July 8, 2025

Case Number: 2024-20, *Sommerfield v. Hall*

Complaint: The Complaint alleged that the Respondent performed engineering without a license.

Resolution: The Board found the Respondent in violation of Ark. Code Ann. §17-30-305 and assessed a civil penalty of \$5,000.

Consent Orders

May 13, 2025

Case Number: 2025-06, *Richardson v. Whitehead*

Complaint: The Complaint alleged that the Respondent renewed his PS license without completing the required PDH hours.

Resolution: The Board found that the Respondent's actions, as described in the Findings of Fact, constituted violations of 17 CAR §285-1006 and §285-1009 of the Board's Rules, as well as Ark. Code Ann. §17-30-307(b)(1). The Respondent was assessed a civil penalty of \$500 and ordered to complete thirty (30) hours of continuing education, including at least two (2) hours in Arkansas Standards of Practice No. 1. These hours must be completed within ninety (90) days of entry of the Order and will not count toward the Respondent's annual continuing education requirement.

September 9, 2025

Case Number: 2025-02, *Dickenson v. Imhoff*

Complaint: The Complaint alleged that the Respondent performed engineering without a license.

Resolution: The Board found the Respondent in violation of Ark. Code Ann. §17-30-305 and assessed a civil penalty of \$500.
